First Aid Plan

1. Each troop is to have a First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position for everyone in the troop. Each Troop to have at least one qualified First Aider on site in their camp.
2. Each Activity base should have a First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position.
3. Each Campsite & Activity Base must have a qualified first aider present at all times.
4. First Aid issues should be addressed in the following sequence:
 - i. The Patrol.
 - ii. The Troop or Activity Base First Aider.
 - iii. The Headquarters First Aid team.
5. Contacting of Emergency Services or Youth Members parents:
Please refer all inquiries to the JOC Staff or Headquarters team only.
6. All communications with family on health issues will be coordinated through the HQ Welfare Team.
7. All incidents **must** to be reported - whether or not they are a “near miss” or an actual “injury” using an HS-15.1 Incident Report Form. This protocol requires Incident Reports to be lodged ‘on line’ by the TROOP LEADER.
