

# North Sydney Smallbore & Air Rifle Club Inc. – Scout Info Sheet

Thank you for contacting North Sydney Small bore & Air Rifle Club Inc (NSSB&ARC) for Firearms Safety Training and shooting. Below is the information about our Scout nights and what you need to do:

## 1. WHEN:

- a. Scout Nights are held either the 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday of the Month from 6:30pm – 9:30pm approx.

## 2. WHERE:

- a. North Sydney Small Bore Club is located off Rosamond Street, Hornsby. We share a common drive with Mt Wilga Private Hospital. Follow the driveway past the hospital car park (on the left) and continue to the last clubhouse on this road. Be careful of the humps. Turn right to our parking area, additional parking can be found around the back.

## 3. WHAT:

- a. A minimum of 6 and a maximum of 12 scouts can attend.
  - The maximum per night is 12. This is because each shooter using a P650 form must have one to one supervision by a licensed member of the Club.
- b. \$40.00 per Scout/Venturer/Rover for two shoots (30 shots)
  - The package includes; electronic target, rifle hire, range hire, ammunition, firearms safety talk, ear plugs etc

## 4. FORMS:

- a. FIREARMS TRAINING REQUEST FORM
  - To be completed and returned ASAP.
  - On receipt of the completed FIREARMS TRAINING REQUEST the Club will assess and confirm the date for the group to attend.
- b. POLICE FORM – P650
  - To be completed by the scout and parent/guardian, and brought to the range on the night. NO FORM, NO SHOOTING, this is a Firearms Registry regulation.
  - The “parent consent” part of the P650 form is to be completed by a parent/guardian. If parent /guardian is not attending with the child, they should attach a photocopy of their Photo ID such as Driving Licence etc. to the P650. Over 18 years shooters such as Rovers do not have to get a parent’s consent
  - Adults may be able to shoot, but must complete a P650 form and produce photo ID.

## 5. IMPORTANT NOTES:

- a. SCOUTS MUST BE AGED 12 YEARS OLD TO SHOOT ON THE NIGHT
- b. SCOUTS MUST WEAR CLOSED IN SHOES FOR SHOOTING
- c. IT IS ADVISABLE TO WEAR LONG SLEEVE TOPS TO PROTECT ELBOWS AND LONG TROUSERS FOR MOSQUITOES

- e. LONG HAIR TO BE TIED BACK
- f. SPECTATORS EG. PARENTS OR WAITING PARTICIPANTS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN THE FIRING LINE/RANGE AREA AND MUST VIEW FROM THE GLASS DOORS INSIDE THE CLUB HOUSE.
