<b>Adventure Dives:</b>	Underwater Navigation, Deep Adventure Dives, Boat Diving, Night Diving & Drift Diving
<b>Course Structure:</b>	Participants will complete PADI Advanced Open Water Diver eLearning for the nominated Adventure Dives. (Completed Prior to attending the Practical Weekend); Saturday: Knowledge Reviews & 3x Dives in Tweed River including 1x Night Dive Sunday: Knowledge Reviews & 2x Boat Dives Monday: Additional 2x Boat Dives (for those who want a little bit more time in the water)
<b>Course Costs:</b> <small>(Includes Gear Hire)</small>	PADI Advanced Open Water Dive Course with 5 Dives (Saturday & Sunday Only) = \$395.00 PADI Advanced Open Water Dive Course with 7 Dives (Saturday to Monday) = \$495.00

<b>Prerequisites</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Minimum 15 Years of Age</li> <li>➤ PADI Open Water Diver certification (or other qualifying certification);</li> <li>➤ Must have completed at least 1 logged dive in the 6 months prior to attending this course;</li> <li>➤ Complete Diver Medical Form &amp; where required obtain a Medical Clearance for diving activities;</li> <li>➤ Where a participant is under 18 years of age a Signed Youth Diving: Responsibility &amp; Risks Acknowledgement is to be completed by the youth members Parent/Guardian.</li> <li>➤ Your own Face Mask, Snorkel &amp; Fins (Due to COVID-19)</li> </ul>



The PADI Advanced Open Water Diver eLearning is designed to improve your underwater knowledge and skills. You can enrol immediately after earning your PADI Open Water Diver certification regardless of your skill level. The course helps you build confidence in navigation, fine-tune buoyancy skills and introduces you to different diving activities such as wreck diving, night diving or underwater imaging. After completing your eLearning, you'll make five Adventure Dives: a deep dive (beyond 18m/60F), a navigation dive, and three additional Adventure Dives.

During the Deep Adventure Dive, you learn how to plan dives to deal with the physiological effects and challenges of deeper scuba diving. The Underwater Navigation Adventure Dive refines your compass navigation skills and helps you better navigate using kick-cycles, visual landmarks and time. Completion of the Advanced Open Water Diver Certification is a prerequisite for the Rescue Diver Certification Course if a Scout is seeking to attain **AQUATICS: Stage 8 // SCUBA**.
