First Aid Plan

1. Each Scout is to have a Personal First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position for everyone in the patrol.
2. Each Activity base should have a First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position.
3. Each Campsite must have a substantial First Aid Kit that is in an easily accessible position.
4. First Aid issues should be addressed in the following sequence:
 - i. The Patrol.
 - ii. The Activity Base First Aider.
 - iii. The Campsite First Aid team.
5. Contacting of Emergency Services or Youth Members parents will be assessed at the time of the incident following Scouts NSW policies.
6. All communications with family on health issues will be coordinated through the Leadership Course Welfare Team.
7. All incidents **must** to be reported - whether or not they are a “near miss” or an actual “injury” using an HS-15.1 Incident Report Form. This protocol requires Incident Reports to be lodged ‘on line’ by the camp coordinator.
